Young People's Drug and Alcohol Team (YPDAT)

Service Details

Treatment provision for people under 18, who live in Southend, to address their drug and/or alcohol misuse.

YPDAT also provides a service for 18-21 year olds with drug misuse issues. This service will work with those who are misusing a wide range of substances, but will not be working with those with opiate and/or crack cocaine use. Those over the age of 18 who are misusing opiates and/or crack cocaine will be referred to Southend Treatment And Recovery Service (CGL).

Tuesday - 9am to 5.30pm

Wednesday - 9am to 5.30pm

Thursday - 9am to 7pm (4pm to 7pm is Drop-In.)

Friday - 9am to 4.30pm

Open Access Drop-In is from 4pm to 7pm on Thursdays at Civic 2. Parent advice and consultation can be provided within the Thursday Drop-In session. (Drop-In has now returned to Civic 2.)
